



DEPARTMENT OF ENGLISH COMMUNICATIVE ENGLISH LANGUAGE CLASS 4th December 2019







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

BEAUTY OF MATHEMATICS

'A Glimpse into Calculus'

Department has conducted a one day workshop for first year students named A Glimpse into Calculus. Dr. Sudheer, (Associate Professor, Retired from Farook College) has conducted the session. The Objective of the program was to motivate students in mathematical subjects by giving basics of algebra and Calculus. Colonel Nizar Ahammed Seethi (COO, SAFI and SIAS) inaugurated the Workshop with his very motivating words to students. Mr.Abdul Samad C (Head of the Department) presided over the Workshop.

Dr. Sudheer has explained basic concepts of Calculus with simple examples. Calculus is the study of how things change. It provides a framework for modelling systems in which there is change, and a way to deduce the predictions of such models. We have **been around for a while, and know how things change, more or less. What can calculus add to that?** We know lots about how things change. And you have a qualitative notion of calculus. For example, the concept



of speed of motion is a notion straight from calculus, though it surely existed long before calculus did and you know lots about it.

In mathematics education, *calculus* denotes courses of elementary mathematics analysis, which are mainly devoted to the study of functions and limits. The word *calculus* is a Latin word, meaning originally "small pebble. Because such pebbles were used for calculation, the meaning of the word has evolved and today usually means a method of computation. It is therefore used for naming specific methods of calculation and related theories. Basic Calculus is the study of differentiation and integration. Both concepts are based on the idea of limits and functions. Some concepts like continuity, exponents are the foundation of advanced calculus. Basic calculus explains about the two different types of calculus called "Differential Calculus" and "Integral Calculus". Differential Calculus helps to find the rate of change of a quantity whereas integral calculus helps to find the quantity when the rate of change is known.


